
Reference is invited to your RTI application dated 16.3.2015 (received in this Ministry on 25.03.2015) seeking certain information in respect of 1950-1977 batch IFS officers, who have since retired.

2. The information sought by you at para 2 of your application does not exist at a single source in a compiled form as defined in Section 2(f) of the RTI Act, 2005. Dear Sir,

Kindly provide true certified copies of the following four items of information.

Kindly note that government servants mentioned below refers only to 1950-1977 batch Indian Administrative Service (IAS), Indian Police Service (IPS), and Indian Foreign Service (IFS) officers who may be either dead or alive currently:

1. List of government servants (name, designation, batch) whose pay was docked during active service due to work related incompetence/negligence or any other sort of professional misconduct.
2. List of government servants (name, designation, batch) whose pension was either cancelled/reduced or affected in any other manner due to professional misconduct.

List of retired government servants (name, designation, batch) who are presently employed by the Government of India and thus drawing a government salary concurrent with their pension amount.

4. List of professional misconducts for which government servants as defined above were penalized either in their pay or in their pension or in both. Such penalties may have been imposed either during active service or post-retirement or during both.

Kindly do not withhold the information sought, by citing lack of resources or by citing that providing this information would be an unnecessary diversion of government resources. This is because I may need the information to obtain a payment of Rs. 57 crores from the Government of India. This payment has been delayed for six months by both active and retired senior IAS, IPS, and IFS officers currently working in important offices of the government like the PMO, Ministry of External Affairs, etc... As such, the information sought in this RTI application is paramount to obtaining my payment as quickly as possible.

Kindly note, this payment dispute is not subjudice at the moment and as such you are free to release the requested four items of information as detailed above within the prescribed time limit stated in the RTI Act, 2005, i.e. in 30 days.

A copy of my passport is attached as proof of my Indian citizenship.
