2. It is learnt from the records available with East Asia Division that Consular Section of the Ministry of External Affairs as well as the Consulate General of India, Osaka-Kobe had intimated Smt Tej Kaur, daughter of Late Shri Nanak Singh Anand on the procedure to be adopted to initiate the process of tracking down the properties. The matter was further pursued with the Consulate as late as in January 2015 following receipt of letters received from you. In view of the fact that there had been no material change in the situation, it was reiterated that Smt. Tej Kaur needed to make a proper application to the concerned local office in Japan, deposit fees and pursue the matter through a designated legal representative. It was further clarified by our Consulate that no records pertaining to Late Shri Nanak Singh Anand's property was available with them.

3. The undersigned met the applicant regarding this matter on 11th February, 2015 in his office premises in South Block.

4. If you are aggrieved with this reply, you may file an appeal to Shri Sujit Ghosh, Director (EA) & Appellate Authority, Room No. 183 B, South Block, Ministry of External Affairs, New Delhi, within a month from the date of receipt of this letter.
