You have sought information regarding gifts received by Dr. Manmohan Singh, former Prime Minister of India and his family during his tenure. It may be mentioned here that Toshakhana deals with the gifts received from foreign sources only. The details of gifts received from foreign sources includes the identity of donor of the gifts i.e. names of countries/ dignitaries/ individuals who presented the gifts. However, the names of countries or sources of gifts cannot be disclosed as this Ministry has been exempted from the same vide CIC's order No. CIC/AD/C/2009/000802 dated 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2009 (available on CIC's website). Information regarding gifts received by Dr. Manmohan Singh as Prime Minister of India and his family from foreign countries/sources with effect from May, 2004 to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2013, after severing names of the donor countries/ sources has been compiled and the same are attached herewith as Annexure-I and Annexure-II respectively.
